Over the Pastor's Shoulder

Do you renounce Satan?
And all his ways?
And all his works?
Do you believe in God the Father...
in Jesus Christ ...
in the Holy Spirit?

Ash Wednesday (February 10) marks the beginning of Lent. Lent is best viewed as a journey, a journey from no to yes, from death to life. We get 40 days to work up to our answer, to say yes.

To be sure, we all have our own Lenten strategies to make the journey from no to yes. Allow me to offer my own suggestions, six of them, three to do and three to start.

First one to do: Say no to indiscriminate television watching. TV has a way of sucking us into a life that is counter to the gospel. You really can't absorb all those images and secular values, day in and day out without being affected and spiritually desensitized. I don't say cut-out TV all together – for most, I think that would lead to serious withdrawal – but I suggest that for Lent you limit yourself and your children to an hour or two a day. Be selective.

Second one: If you say no to television, say yes to spiritual reading. I suggest the Covenant Home Altar or a spiritual classic such as Augustine's "Confessions" (you can probably pick up a copy on Amazon for a very reasonable price). I also recommend John Baillie's "A Diary of Readings"; I promise this book will strengthen and stretch your spirit. I have a copy to loan out if anyone is interested.

Third: A can on the table. That is put a can or other container on the kitchen table and every day have each family member empty his or her loose change into it. Designate that change for the poor. Might I suggest giving to either Covenant World Relief or Together We Cope. You decide. Just remember that change is to be given to the poor.

Fourth suggestion for Lent: Be an encourager. That is, at home, at work, at school, share an encouraging word, offer up an encouraging deed at least once a day. Be extravagant in your encouragement.

Fifth suggestion – and this is tough: work to repair and heal damaged relationships. In my experience, broken relationships often begin with a misunderstanding. Do what you can to move toward mutual understanding. Listening, a forgiving spirit and words like "I am sorry" are key to this process.

Sixth and final suggestion: Reconnect basics. Put aside a day every week when you can reconnect with family and friends. I guess I'm saying sometimes we get so busy that we don't have time for those we love the most. Tell me what is more important than spending meaningful time with family and friends – I can't think of anything.

So, my six Lenten suggestions. The first three: no to TV, yes to spiritual reading, and a can on the family table. The second three: be an encourager, work at healing a broken relationship, and reconnect with family and friends. All six are ways of getting from Ash Wednesday's no to Easter's yes.

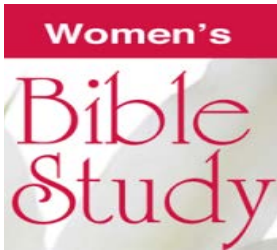
